TOUCHY TREASURES TRAIL



This 'Touchy Treasures Trail' will help you to learn more about texture.

The 'treasures' are found all round the Heritage Trail – you may not find them all in one visit.

Take this list with you, as well as some wax crayons and sheets of blank paper. When you find a 'treasure', place the paper over it (you may need someone to help you hold the paper in place) and gently make a rubbing. After you have finished, tick the box below, and then look for your next 'treasure'. The list can be done in any order.

1. Pine tree bark (clue : evergreen tree with 'needles' in pairs)
2. Birch tree bark (clue : look for 'silver' bark, tree leafless in winter)
3. Beech tree bark (clue : big trees between Mary's Gate and Kinross)
4. Tree rings on a wooden seat (clue : look for a seat with an armrest)
5. A 'knot' in wooden fencing or a building (clue : Birdwatching Hides)
6. Seat medallion showing something about nature
7. Seat medallion showing something about people
8. Letters carved in stone (can you find your initials?)
9. A stone made of millions of tiny sand grains (clue : go to a Gateway)
10. Not rubbings, but can you find these textures? Write down your examples

Something soft

Something hard

Something spiky

Something natural that is perfectly round

Note : Please take a grown-up to help you find 'Touchy Treasures'.

There is no need to go far from the Trail : everything is on the Trail, certainly no more than one or two paces away.
